



Hello Curlers;

It is that time of year again where we can start looking forward to a new season of competitive curling in the Big Rock Edmonton Super League. Once again this year, we will be playing for over \$25,000 in cash and prizes.

The Board of Directors would like to thank you for your support over the last few years as the format of the league has been evolving. The Board has been working during the off-season setting up for the coming season. The most notable changes for this upcoming season are listed below. Please take the time to read this section in full.

- The entry fee for this season has yet to be determined but will be between \$2,100.00 and \$2,200 per team.
- We will continue with the weekly payouts of \$150.00 per win.
- Payouts during the playoffs will stay at a total of \$7,000.
- The increase in fees for the season is due to an increase in ice fees. It is noteworthy that our ice fees were also offset by a new sponsor, Fort-In-View Golf Course.
- The Super League will once again be 16 teams. Should more than 16 teams register a points system and retention criteria will apply. The points system and criteria is included with this registration form and must be filled in when the form is submitted. Failure to fill in the points forms will result in zero points being awarded to your team which may affect your entry into the league. Retention is solely based on last years performance and returning team members.
- The first 4 spots will be awarded based on the points your team members accumulated. The next 10 spots in the league will be awarded to the next 10 teams based on retention criteria, for those teams who have not yet qualified through points. The final 2 spots will be awarded to the winner of the 2 events in the Qualifying spiel.
- If we have more than 16 teams entered in the SuperLeague for the coming year, the qualifying bonspiel will run during the weeknights of the third week in September for those teams who may need to qualify. If a team does not qualify for the SuperLeague, the \$600 deposit can be applied to entry into another league within the SSC. Otherwise the deposit is forfeited.
- The Men's and Women's Super Leagues will both be curling on Wednesday nights at 6:15 and 8:45pm. Please note that as with previous years the leagues will NOT be amalgamated. Once again we will be curling on the opposite draw from the Women's League except for pre-season play where we will be mixing it up a bit.
- The league will run 1 division of 16 teams. This will mean that each team will play every other team in the league once before the playoff round. This format will make the season consist of 1 exhibition game, 15 regular season games, a skins game (late January, not before city zones as previous years) and a 16 team playoff round, resulting in a maximum of 20 games for the season.
- The Super League will once again have its' Ice Committee. Composed of respected members from each league, communicating with Head Ice Technician, Bruce Bourgionion, and Curling Operations Manager, Rob Krepps, their specific goal is to improve ice conditions. We are looking for people willing to be a part of this committee.

This exhibition game will be played Wednesday, September 28/2011 or October 5/2011, depending on the timing of the rest of the season. All teams are expected to be in attendance for the exhibition game. Your remaining league fees, if not already paid in full, are due that night. Your team will not collect any winnings until your fees are paid.

2011-2012 EDMONTON SUPER LEAGUE QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

The 2011-2012 Edmonton Super League will include a total of 16 Men's Teams. 14 Teams will pre-qualify as follows:

1. The first 4 Teams to pre-qualify will be based on a new Cumulative Points System. This system recognizes individual performance in Major Championships (Brier, Canada Cup, Players', and Olympic Trials), in Selected Other Championships (Men's Regionals & Provincials, Senior Men's Provincials & Nationals, Junior Men's Provincials & Nationals, and University Men's Nationals), in World Curling Tour Events, and in the Edmonton Super League.
2. As many as 10 Teams will then pre-qualify based on their performance in the 2010-2011 Edmonton Super League regular season. Please note that these teams must meet the minimum team retention criteria (2 returning players including the fourth-rock thrower, or 3 returning players not including the fourth-rock thrower). It should also be noted that these teams must have finished in the top 14 in the 2010-11 Super League regular season.
3. In the event that any berths remain to get to the total of 14 teams that will pre-qualify, the Edmonton Super League reserves the right to award one or more special exemptions based on historical performance, future potential, and/or extenuating circumstances. Please note that any available berths not awarded by way of special exemption will revert to the Cumulative Points System mentioned above.
4. Any teams that do not pre-qualify will still have access by way of a Pre-Season Double Knock-Out Playdown, which will determine the final 2 Teams in the 2011-2012 Edmonton Super League.
